Start it Out | Goal: Get people talking

- Was there a time in your life that you remember standing up for someone? What was the situation and what did it feel like to stand up for them? Was who they were or their identity a factor in standing up?
- Pastor Steve said, "Love is a decision, a commitment, an action, not a feeling." Do you agree or disagree?

Talk it Out | Goal: Get the group talking about scripture

- Read **Luke 10:29**; ²⁹ The man wanted to justify his actions, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" Based on Jesus' response of the Parable of the Good Samaritan, who is our neighbor?
- List of all the ways the despised Samaritan showed love and care for the man found on the road. How do these actions compare to the actions of Jesus' love for humanity?
- Read **1 John 4:12**; What are some examples of God's love being "brought to full expression in us?"

Live it Out | Goal: Choose a question to encourage next steps

- Jesus said, "go and do" not "sit and stay," what does it look like for you to "go and do" this week?
- Many in the world want to be revolutionary, yet never get passed the point of protest. What is one thing you can do this week to start a revolution of love for God's Kingdom?
- What qualifiers guides your love for others? Maybe a better way to ask the question is, what qualifiers do you need to drop in order to truly love someone? (Ex. social status, political views, race, gender)
