EQUATIONS OF DISCIPLESHIP

The Popular Equation:

Salvation + Time + Individual Willpower = Spiritual Growth

The Holiness Equation:

Grace + Cooperation with God + Christian Community = Christlikeness

Start it Out | Goal: Get people talking

- Read the quote from Pastor Steve and ask, "When reorienting your heart for Sanctification what does a 'cooperative effort between you and God' look like to you?"

Talk it Out | Goal: Get the group talking about scripture

- Read 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24. Based on this passage of scripture how would you define sanctification?
- In your opinion what does it look like for your "whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless?"
- Read 1 Corinthians 3:2. Knowing that Paul was talking to born again believers, what does the scripture indicate about the role of sin even after salvation?
- Leader: Discuss further the implications of sanctification and the role of holiness after salvation

Live it Out | Goal: Choose a question to encourage next steps

- Review the <u>4 Truths of Sanctification</u>: 1. Starts at salvation 2. Involves more than time 3. Cooperation with God and intentional training 4. Is a communal effort. Ask: What are your thoughts on Sanctification based on these 4 truths?
- Review the **EQUATIONS OF DISCIPLESHIP,** What do you see as the main difference between the Popular Equation and the Holiness Equation?
