⁵ "Master," Simon replied, "we worked hard all last night and didn't catch a thing. But if you say so, I'll let the nets down again." ⁶ And this time their nets were so full of fish they began to tear! ⁷ A shout for help brought their partners in the other boat, and soon both boats were filled with fish and on the verge of sinking.

⁸ When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, "Oh, Lord, please leave me—I'm such a sinful man." ⁹ For he was awestruck by the number of fish they had caught, as were the others with him. ¹⁰ His partners, James and John, the sons of Zebedee, were also amazed.

Jesus replied to Simon, "Don't be afraid! From now on you'll be fishing for people!" ¹¹ And as soon as they landed, they left everything and followed Jesus.

- Has Jesus ever asked you to give your effort, to borrow your stuff, or utilize your time for his work? If so, give an example.
- Read Luke 5:4-5, What excuses have you give Jesus when He's asked you to serve Him? What is a time when you have been "reluctant disciple."

Live it Out | Goal: Choose questions to encourage next steps

- Read Luke 5:10-11, What does it look like or mean for you to be a "Fisher of people?"
- Jesus' mission is simple, "Follow and Fish," but the execution is hard; How to do we get past what is hard and live out Jesus' mission?
- Respond to this quote from Pastor Steve: "The most important thing
 is NOT that Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow
 him; the most important thing is that they followed."
