Start it Out | Goal: Get people talking

- Do you remember a time when you were scared so you ran and hid? If comfortable, share with the group.
- Why do you think people live in denial?
- Have you ever made a promise you didn't keep?
- Why do people use the phrase, "never say never.?"

Talk it Out | Goal: Get the group talking about scripture

- Denial 1: Read Matthew 26:69-70, Based on these two verses what do you think led to Peter's first denial? (*observation: "in front of everyone."*) Have you ever denied something because of peer pressure? Explain.
- **Denial 2:** Read **Matthew 26:71-72**, What do you notice about Peter's second denial?
- **Denial 3:** Read **Matthew 26:73-74**, Describe this scene as you picture it in your mind.
- Read Luke 22:61, What do you think was going through Jesus' mind? How do you think Jesus looked at Peter?

Live it Out | Goal: Choose questions to encourage next steps

- Reflect on the question, How are you denying Jesus?
- Discuss as a group different ways we deny Jesus in our lives? Write them down and discuss.
- What does it mean for Jesus to "see" you?
- How can you live this week working on not denying Jesus?

Pray it Out | Goal: Lift up prayers, petitions, and praises

 How can we pray for you this week? Take notes and follow up next week.
