- Why is it important that the religious leaders described Peter and John the way they did?
- What do you believe it means when Pastor Steve says, "If we will preach *no other name*, we should also make it evident that we have been with Jesus.
- Your application for this week is to live in such a way that there is evidence you've been with Jesus.
